- (c) Copy of Academic transcript, which includes "April 2022 to March 2023" and "April 2023 to March 2024".



English version transcript or 習得科目の確認表 is preferable.

(d) CV (Inquire if you need a sample.)

Conduct research at a research group in University of Michigan, UCLA, North Carolina State University, New York University, University of Washington, or University of Toronto.

Contacting the host professor

Once you have found research theme(s) in which you are interested, get in touch with the corresponding professor(s) and ask them if they accept you as a visiting graduate scholar. Remember that there are many students from all over the world who are willing to study as visiting scholars, thus it is very competitive. As such, we strongly recommend you prepare the documents which show the evidence of your research skills/knowledge/experience as much as possible. A recommendation letter

from your supervisor at Nagoya University may help, or you may want to ask your supervisor to write an email at the first contact.

Important notes

• You are supposed to have obtained your host professor's acceptance of you by the deadline. We will NOT allow your participation if you have not got any positive response by the application deadline.

• Applicants who want to stay at UCLA must take account of the rule that one must present an evidence of financial support more than 130,000 yen/month from non-personal funds. Inquire at **JUACEP office**.

• Upon contacting, should use your Nagoya University e-mail account.

• When contacting a lab at NYU or UT, you should contact the coordinator first.

Course Credit

Course name: International Research Project Seminar I U2

2 credits are given to the Medium- and Long-term-course students.

Enrolled students will receive a certificate from Nagoya University upon completion of the course.

Eligibility (All of the following conditions must be satisfied.)

- (a) Graduate student at the Graduate School of Engineering, Nagoya University as of April 2024.
- (b) Student who will continue study/get degree at Nagoya University after the program.
- (c) "<u>成績評価係数</u>" must be greater than 2.30. **International students are not eligible* to receive a JASSO scholarship support.

Out-of-Pocket Expenses

- Participation fee: 10,000 yen
- Round-trip ticket between Japan and USA or Canada
- House rent for the whole duration of the stay in the US or Canada
- Student health insurance ruled by each university
- Private travel insurance
- Visa application fee (including transportation fee for interview)
- Visiting Scholar processing charge (like VGR fee for UCLA)
- Others (living expenses etc.)

Financial Supports

Scholarship by JASSO will be granted to the qualified students: monthly 80,000 yen for UM, UT, UW, or NCSU, monthly 100,000 yen for UCLA or NYU. Recipients will be notified at the same time of the notice of acceptance.

Immigration status
